SCHOLARSHIP GUIDELINES

Realizing that the youth of today will be the future of tomorrow, the purpose of this scholarship is to assist with the continued education and further development of those potential leaders.

The Blue Knight's I.L.E.M.C. Inc., Mason Dixon Conference, will make available two (2) \$500.00 college scholarships to **immediate family members of the Conference.** For the purpose of this scholarship, immediate family members shall be described as: Son/stepson, Daughter/stepdaughter or Grandchildren.

The MDC Chairman shall appoint a scholarship committee, consisting of not less than 3, nor more than 5 members, of the conference to review all applications and make the **final** decision regarding those selected.

If there are less than two (2) applications received, it shall be the MDC Board of Directors decision whether to increase the amount to the maximum \$1,000.00 which was budgeted.

In the case of no applications being received, the budgeted monies shall remain in the MDC treasury and not added to the next year's selection process.

In an effort to assist the majority of the membership, once this scholarship has been awarded to an applicant, **that applicant is no longer eligible for future MDC scholarships.**

Blank applications will be made available, by the conference, at the MDC winter meeting and must be postmarked and returned to the committee chairman no later than the date specified on the application. Once the application date has passed, the committee chairman shall contact the other committee members and begin the selection process. After the process has been completed, the committee chairman shall notify the MDC Chairman in order to announce it at the spring business meeting and the applicants selected will be notified by mail.

Due to the nature of college choices often being changed, once the final college selection has been made, the selected applicant will notify the MDC Treasurer and a check shall be issued in the **name of the college and the applicant.**

Criteria to be considered during the selection process should include but not be limited to: the following:

- Content, quality of required essay & application
- Attendance record
- Grade Point Average
- Academic courses required for degree(s)
- Amount of Tuition VS Lodging
- Outside financial concerns
